



GameChange Solar bags 200 MW of tracker orders in Colombia

July 12 (Renewables Now) - US-based solar racking manufacturer GameChange Solar said that it has secured orders to supply 200 MW of trackers for projects in Colombia.

It said it had picked up orders for its proprietary Genius Tracker systems, and started shipping the equipment this month.

The trackers will be used in three "important projects" Solar project in Florida, USA. Source: in Colombia, GameChange Solar added in the press release. No other details were disclosed.

Colombian national grid operator XM Compania Expertos en Mercado expects the country to incorporate over 3,000 MW of new capacity in 2022, projecting that solar power would account for about half of that, it said in April.

During the first six months of the year, only four small-scale solar projects -- the largest of them being 9.9-MW schemes -- came online in Colombia, according to XM's quarterly updates.
